The National Rehabilitation Hospital (NRH) is the national tertiary referral centre in Ireland providing Complex Specialist Rehabilitation services to adult and paediatric patients from throughout Ireland. At the NRH, services are delivered to patients who, as a result of an accident, illness or injury have acquired a physical or cognitive disability, or both, and require a specialist interdisciplinary programme of rehabilitation. Rehabilitation Programmes at the NRH are delivered by Consultant-led Interdisciplinary Teams in the following areas of speciality:

- Brain Injury (including traumatic, and non-traumatic brain injury, and Stroke or other neurological conditions)
- Spinal Cord System of Care (including traumatic, and non-traumatic spinal cord injury)
- Prosthetic, Orthotic and Limb Absence Rehabilitation (POLAR)
- Paediatric Family-Centred Programme

The NRH is undergoing major redevelopment and a new hospital is currently being built. Services at the NRH are accredited by CARF (Commission for Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities), an internationally recognised, independent accreditation system.
