

Senior Physiotherapist -Brain Injury Programme Permanent/Temporary – Full Time/Part Time + Panel

Applications are invited for the above post from suitably qualified persons.

The post holder will co-ordinate and implement the physiotherapy service within the Brain Injury Programme. She/he will provide physiotherapy assessment and treatment to patients within the Brain Injury Programme in line with current best practice in consultation with the Brain Injury Programme Manager and Physiotherapy Manager and other relevant staff and will initiate and develop appropriate team protocols, policies and education modules within the Brain Injury Programme.

The candidate must, on the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office, possess:

- B.Sc. /Master's Degree in Physiotherapy.
- A qualification in Physiotherapy equivalent to the above.
- Membership of, or eligibility for membership of the Irish Society of Chartered Physiotherapists and CORU registered or pending same.
- A minimum of 3 years post graduate experience with at least 1 year in the area of Acquired Brain Injury/Stroke rehabilitation.
- Evidence of post graduate clinical education in the area of Acquired Brain Injury (e.g. Bobath Introductory Modules or Basic Bobath Course or Carr & Shepherd Course).
- Excellent organisational and leadership skills.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Evidence of continuing professional development.
