This role provides an exciting opportunity for a Consultant in Rehabilitation Medicine to be involved in shaping the future of neurorehabilitation services in Ireland.

The advertised post will be one of 3 WTE Consultant in Rehabilitation Medicine posts supporting the delivery of specialist rehabilitation services across NRH, Peamount/CHO 7 and Dublin Midlands Hospital Group Network. The overarching aim is the development of neuro- rehabilitation services to improve patient outcomes by providing safe, high quality, person -centred neuro-rehabilitation at the lowest appropriate level of complexity in line with the National Clinical Programme for Rehabilitation Medicine Model of Care (MOC) and the Neuro-rehabilitation Strategy Implementation Framework (IF). These services will be configured into population based managed clinical rehabilitation networks (MCRNs).

Funding has been approved which will see the introduction of an inpatient neurorehabilitation unit at Peamount Healthcare. The additional inpatient service at Peamount will be a key development within the managed clinical rehabilitation network demonstrator project.



The new consultant post will see both new and enhanced services across the Network – including;
