Clinical Specialist Occupational Therapist Brain Injury Programme (Permanent – Full Time)

Purpose of the Position:

The post holder will also carry a clinical caseload within the Brain Injury programme.

Requirements:

The candidate must, on the latest date for receiving completed application forms for the office, possess:

- B.Sc. /Master's Degree in Occupational Therapy approved by the Occupational Therapists Registration Board at CORU
- CORU registered at the time of application (Please include CORU membership number on application)
- A minimum of 5 years post graduate experience with a minimum of 3 years in the area of acquired brain injury.
- Experience of teaching and mentoring students, staff, and senior grade therapists.
- Experience in clinical research.
