Resuscitation Officer Clinical Nurse Manager II (Permanent & Full Time)

The Resuscitation Officer will be responsible for the co-ordination and management of the Resuscitation Service in the National Rehabilitation Hospital. This will involve planning, organisation, implementation and evaluation of all Basic and Advanced life support training for appropriate personnel.

The Resuscitation Officer will be responsible for the supervision, review and audit of resuscitation procedures. The Resuscitation Officer will assist in promoting the importance of resuscitation throughout the hospital and supporting staff to be competent and up to date in their Resuscitation skills appropriate for their level.

REQUIREMENTS:
