



Staff Grade Psychologist (Temporary/Part-time 0.9 WTE)

For this locum post, the initial designation is to the POLAR Programme, which is dedicated to the care of patients who have experienced limb loss following trauma or disease.

The candidate **must** at the time of application for the post possess:

- A recognised University Degree or Diploma obtained with first- or second-class honours in which Psychology was taken as a major subject and honours obtained in that subject or hold a recognised qualification equivalent to above
- Hold a recognised post-graduate qualification in psychology

- Clinical practice with people living with chronic disease and or mental health difficulties
- Clinical or research experience in the practice of neuropsychology
