



Senior Psychologist (Permanent, Part-Time 0.8)

The Department of Psychology provides a range of clinical services including psychological assessment, psychotherapy, behavioural and other clinical and educational interventions for the patients and their families/carers. This post offers the candidate the opportunity to deliver the best psychological practice in neurorehabilitation with a team of clinical specialists and for this post the primary designation is to the Spinal Cord System of Care (SCSC).

The candidate must at the time of application possess:

- A recognised University Degree or Diploma obtained with first or second class honours in which Psychology was taken as a major subject and honours obtained in that subject
- A recognised postgraduate professional psychological qualification appropriate to the area of professional psychology in which the position is designated.
- Minimum of five years satisfactory postgraduate experience in the area of professional psychology in which the position is designated i.e. SCSC. The five years' experience must be comprised of no more than three years of postgraduate training and no less than two years (Whole Time Equivalent) experience as a Staff Grade Psychologist.
- The requisite clinical, operational and management knowledge and ability for the proper discharge of the duties of the office.
- Experience undertaking clinical research and audit.
- Experience of service development
- Demonstrate evidence of leadership initiatives and management.

It is desirable for the candidate to have experience in the following:

- Experience working in a hospital setting
- Experience of working with patients with acquired disability
- Training in clinical supervision of psychologists and or experience of providing the same
