ADVANCED NURSE PRACTITIONER, candidate (cANP) Paediatric Rehabilitation

(Permanent, Full Time)

Applications are invited for this exciting new post in the NRH Paediatric Programme from suitably qualified persons

The purpose of the post is to provide safe, timely, evidence-based nurse-led care to children with complex rehabilitation needs at an advanced nursing level, using evidence based clinical guidelines to promote and enable quality healthcare. The role will provide clinical leadership and professional scholarship to develop nursing practice and health policy in paediatric rehabilitation at local, regional, and national level.

The cANP post holder will undertake the academic preparation and develop the clinical and leadership to be registered as a RANP with NMBI. The candidate ANP is required to progress to registration with Bord Altranais agus Cnáimhseachais na hÉireann (Nursing and Midwifery Board of Ireland) (NMBI) as a Registered Advanced Nurse Practitioner (RANP) within 3 years of commencement of this post.

The post holder will develop the job description and supporting documentation under the direction of the Health Care Provider's Advanced Practice Stakeholder Governance Group, to enable the individual nurse to meet the NMBI Criteria for Registration as an Advanced Nurse Practitioner as set out in Advanced Practice (Nursing) Standards and Requirements (NMBI, 2017).
