

Senior Dietitian (Permanent, Part-time)

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons for the above vacancy.

The role includes promotion and support of health by means of sound nutritional advice and/or nutritional intervention within the National Rehabilitation Hospital. The successful candidate will be responsible for assessing the nutritional status of each patient referred, estimating individual nutritional requirements, and devising, monitoring and reviewing individualized care plans as appropriate. They will educate relatives or carers on the relevant aspects of the patient's nutritional support or therapeutic diet as well as assisting the Dietitian Manager in developing educational materials and resources for individual patients and patient groups. In addition, they will assist the Dietitian Manager in devising and implementing nutritional policies for the hospital.
